

**WAKESHMA TOWNSHIP, KALAMAZOO COUNTY  
LOCAL ROAD MILLAGE BALLOT LANGUAGE**

WHEREAS, the Township Board of Wakeshma Township wishes to provide additional road construction, improvement and maintenance services on local roads within the jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, townships may impose and levy ad valorem property taxes to finance lawful public services, as authorized by the Michigan Constitution of 1963 and other laws; and

WHEREAS, the Township Board of Wakeshma Township wishes to levy 3.0 mills to provide funds for local road repairs, upgrades, maintenance, and improvements and for road drainage and drainage systems; for a period of 10 years.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Township Board of Wakeshma Township, Kalamazoo County approves the following millage ballot question language and directs the Clerk to submit it to be placed on the November, 2018 election ballot:

**WAKESHMA TOWNSHIP LOCAL ROAD MILLAGE**

Shall Wakeshma Township impose an increase of up to 3.0 mills (\$3.00 per \$1,000 of taxable value) in the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution and levy it for 10 years, 2018 through 2027, inclusive for local road repairs, upgrades, construction, improvement and maintenance purposes, which 3.0 mill increase will raise an estimated \$202,900 in the first year the millage is levied?
