

Important Tax Dates:

- *Summer Taxes are mailed at the end of June and are due in September.
- *Winter Taxes are mailed at the end of November and are due in February.
- *Property taxes must be paid by February 14, 2014.

When paying taxes by mail be sure to enclose the bottom portion of your tax bill with your check or money order. If you want a tax receipt, please send a self-addressed stamped envelope along with your *entire* bill and you will receive the stamped top portion of your tax bill back.

Winter Tax Payment Dates:

The Wakeshma Township Treasurer, Leanne Munn, will be available to collect winter taxes at the Wakeshma Township Hall, 13988 South 42nd Street, Fulton, Michigan.

Winter Tax payment dates:

December, January and February: Mondays from Noon to 5:00pm

Tuesdays from 9:00am to 12:00pm

Due to the Christmas holiday, the office will be closed Tuesday December 24th. The treasurer will be available on Monday December 30th - 9:00am to 5:00pm

Friday, February 14, 2014 – 9:00am to 5:00pm (Last day to pay taxes w/o interest)

Delinquent Taxes: February 15th through the 28th, 2014, taxes may be paid at the Wakeshma Township Hall. Please call 269-778-3728 to get an updated amount, as penalties and interest will be applied.

The treasurer will be in the office on February 28, 2014 for final tax collection from 9:00am to 5:00pm.

Beginning March 1, 2014 all unpaid taxes are delinquent, with penalties and interest and must be paid to the county.
