

## WAKESHMA TOWNSHIP BOARD MEETING MINUTES

JULY 1, 2019

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor Gatlin at 7:00 pm. Additional member present were: Clerk Fritz, Trustee Munn and Trustee Thole. Trustee Bennett was absent.

Clerk Fritz made a motion to approve the consent agenda, Trustee Thole supported. Voice vote, passed. Trustee Thole made a motion to approve the treasurers report, supported by Clerk Fritz. Voice vote, passed.

CITIZENS COMMENTS: It was asked what was happening with the property on V Avenue, this has gone to court and we believe eviction notice has been served.

It was stated that there was a problem with crop dusters, stating that the planes have just started in the area three years ago (with the resident living here 20 years) – supposedly spreading agents that are harmful to pets. This is something the resident needs to call MDAR regarding as it is their responsibility to look into these matters.

State rules for fireworks has changed. You can now shoot fireworks the day before, the day of and the day after a holiday until 11:00 pm on that last day.

It was also suggested that maybe we can have a heads up next year when the bike tour is coming through. The store would like to be stocked up and maybe even get a port a pot set up for their people as there is no bathroom at the store. Janet is more than willing to let them put one up next to the store. The directors of the bike ride admit that it wasn't planned very well and will work on it for next year.

ZONING ENFORCEMENT – Gettys got permits – if they have permits and working on it they are good as long as they are not staying there which it was stated that they are.
