

WAKESHMA TOWNSHIP BOARD MEETING

November 3, 2014

Meeting called to order by Supervisor Deming at 7:30pm. Members present were – Supervisor Deming, Treasurer Munn, and Clerk Fritz. Four citizens also present along with three member of the KCRC.

Account Balances as follows: Tax Checking - \$1042.62, Trust & Agency - \$509.23 which is Parade Monies, General Checking - \$4889.08, General Savings - \$7639.00.

Bill Listing was read. Motion to adjust KCRC bill. Motion to accept by Clerk Fritz, seconded by Treasurer Munn. Approved.

Treasurer's Report was read and approved. Motioned by Supervisor Deming, Seconded by Clerk Fritz.

Old Business – The recycling dumpster issues have been resolved. The dumpsters are scheduled to be delivered on the first Friday of the months of May – November, if the first weekend of the month does not include Friday then the dumpsters are scheduled for the following weekend.

New Business – There is a fee of \$108.00 to residents who wish to purchase a copy of the New Zoning Ordinance. Supervisor Deming is going to look into grants and funding for repairs to the township - sod for the front of the building which needs repairs, new fencing for cemeteries and a new door for the back of the township hall.

Board Comments – The hazardous waste facility we use has said we are out of money due to residence high volume this year, we need to refigure a way so that each resident receives a certain percentage each year and then pay after that so that everyone can utilize this benefit and not have to pay as much.

Citizens Comments – KCRC discussed the U Avenue project. They used \$6500.00 in materials they had at their building to fill potholes on that road. We need to continue a partnership to work together to repair this road and others in the future. Supervisor Deming has meetings with a few of the land owners in the township to possibly vote on a millage in the future to get extra monies for road repairs.
